# 2023 ANNUAL REPORT TO ST. PETER'S LUTHERAN CHURCH From Pastor Janice Kuder

[Presented at annual congregational meeting held January 28, 2024]

As ever, I feel my call is to **grow closer to God** myself and **lead/ teach/ encourage/ mentor everyone at St. Peter's in doing the same**, so that together we truly can *be Christ's Body* here in the Big Falls area and **allow heaven to operate on earth through us, demonstrating His Kingdom**.

My work is about SPIRITUAL GROWTH AND GROWTH OF GOD'S KINGDOM and falls into broad categories:

#### **BIBLE ENGAGEMENT & PRAYER**

- I participated in a Bible Study with a small group beginning in the fall, concluding January, 2024.
- I offered one-on-one **coached prayer (Immanuel Approach)** to several individuals. This way of praying is amazingly effective for emotional healing.
- I led a **Bible Study for Ladies Aid** [Ray VanderLaan's *That the World May Know*, Volumes 12-13] at their monthly meetings from January through August.
- I led many members of St. Peter's to participate in the *Immerse Bible Reading Experience*, starting in January 2023, many of us read the entire New Testament (together) using the *Immerse Reading Bible—Messiah*!

#### SPIRITUAL COMMUNITY

- I facilitated a Christian book study for women (Stasi Eldredge's *Becoming Myself: Embracing God's Dream of You*) which began meeting in September, 2022 and completed in February, 2023. Three to twelve women have participated.
- I continue to meet monthly with my own Small Group for Spiritual Growth.
- I began to **meet with a 'Triad'** (a small group with only 3 members) late in the spring. We meet weekly over a meal to encourage and support each other in our spiritual growth.
- I continue to lead our congregation's **Confirmation Program**: teaching the Small Catechism to 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders; overseeing the 9<sup>th</sup> graders Bible overview experience; mentoring/ training the adult mentors/ small group leaders. Our **Youth Pastor Kay Knight** partnered with me on Wednesdays, to **teach prayer** in our opening worship, and in leading Francis Chan's BASIC study (Who Is God? Who Is the Church?) as part of our study of the Apostles' Creed

#### WORSHIP/ PREACHING/ SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

- I have continued to meet about met once a month with **Pastor Aimee Postel** [The Lakes (of Waupaca)] for ministry and theological discussions.
- I spend significant time each week **preparing sermon messages** from God's word, and planning worship services to help us all praise and serve Him through our worship. I work with the **Worship Committee** to plan worship. We began in September, 2021 to invite at least one congregation member to join us each time we choose hymns/ plan worship.
- I meet monthly with the Trustees and with the Elders (each has a separate monthly meeting), leading and participating in their work of leadership at St. Peter's.

#### MINISTERING TO PHYSICAL & EMOTIONAL NEEDS

- I continue to serve as the MAMA [clergy rep] on the **House of HOPE Board**.
- I continue to work with Nancy Heiman, Director, and others called to **healing ministry** at the **River of God Healing Rooms** (in downtown Marion), which opened in September,

2019, and for which I serve as Associate Director. The team has continued to meet and to offer prayers for healing (by appointment, and twice a month on the first and third Tuesdays).

#### A MAJOR CHANGE IN MY MINISTRY AT ST. PETER'S IN 2023:

Early in the year I began to feel God calling me to something different—that it was time for my ministry as Pastor to draw to an end. In obedience to that call, I announced in June, 2023 that I would retire sometime in 2024—the exact date to be determined by the needs of St. Peter's and the wisdom of the Elders and Trustees as they prepared for this major transition. I set up a Transition Team charged with determining who St. Peter's is and who God is calling St. Peter's to be (writing a congregational profile) and determining what kind of Pastoral leadership they need to do and be that (writing a detailed Pastor Job Description). I also set up a Transition Prayer Team to be covering this whole process in prayer and leading the entire congregation to do the same.

She leaves behind an incredible Sunday School and Youth Ministry which she grew and nurtured over the course of 2 decades. We continue to seek God's guidance in raising up new leaders within St. Peter's to continue these vital ministries.

Pastor Janice Kuder announced her imminent retirement in 2024, and established a Transition Team and a Transition Prayer Team to begin the process of discerning what God is calling St. Peter's to do and be and what kind of Pastoral leadership they will need to do so.

# ANNUAL REPORT TO ST. PETER'S LUTHERAN CHURCH From Pastor Kay Knight For the year 2022

[Presented at annual congregational meeting held January 29, 2023]

Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it. Proverbs 22:6

I prayerfully strive to lead/ teach/ encourage/ mentor all of God's children, no matter the age, at St. Peter's into a personal relationship with Christ, and challenge all of God's children to respond to God's call to serve in their communities and the world.

- I have been **meeting** with Pastor Janice as a way to connect and communicate and work together to grow the faith of our members and the Kingdom of our great God. This year included the special events during the summer months of outdoor worship services including Blessing of Bikes, corn roast, and pig roast.
- I've offered **prayers** and am available to encourage, challenge, and **counsel** the youth, young adults and parents towards effective lives as followers of Jesus (i.e. after-school visits, attendance at extracurricular activities, home visitations, and support during times of crisis, etc.).
- I have planned, organized and participated in **Districts Youth Conference in Green Bay, Faith-Quake in Wisconsin Dells and Stand to Reason Conference in St. Paul, MN.** This also involves coordinating chaperones, meals and all fundraising.
- I've participated in **Bible Studies** with small groups as well as attended online the Youth Pastors Summit. I am continuously working on programming to keep our youth involved, valued and active members of the church and living a Spirit-filled life, so I also participated in monthly Youth Pastor Webinars held by the LCMC and in A Church Tech Conference.
- I have written and led an expository teaching through the book of Revelation on Sunday evenings and the writings of Solomon to a group of non-confirmation "students" on Wednesday evenings.
- I work to keep **communication with post-confirmation youth** to provide opportunities to them that will keep them involved and growing in their faith. This includes common forms of communication for teenagers (Messenger, Snapchat, Instagram, etc.)
- I have been **teaching prayer** in our opening worship for confirmation classes on Wednesday night.
- I continue to **lead and work closely with all Sunday school staff** including giving direct support to them as they teach the Truth and Word of God to our **Sunday-school aged children**.
- I am responsible for putting together schedules, all curriculum, and providing materials and direction for Sunday school and Vacation Bible school. I make every effort to speak to all students and teachers every week to build a trusting, safe and caring relationship with each of them. I faithfully work to recognize the gifts and talents of other staff members and maintain a strong teamwork mentality.
- **Regular communication with parents** to assist them in fulfilling their promises made at their children's baptisms.
- I spend significant time each week **preparing children's sermon/lessons** from God's Word, and planning special programming including Christmas and Good Friday programs to help us all praise and serve Him through our worship.
- I am responsible, with the guidance from Christ our Lord, for **recruiting and training volunteers** in various aspects of youth, and young adult ministry and ensure adequate adult to youth ratios.
- I meet monthly with the Elders, participating in their work of leadership at St. Peter's.
- I have covered and **lead worship services** while Pastor was on vacation to ensure that all congregation members still had the opportunity to worship as their faith community.

- I also have provided pastoral coverage to our brothers in sisters in the faith and provide support during their time of need of pastors.
- I planned and executed two middle-school/high school **lock-ins this year** where the teenagers are free to bring their own personalities into the church building and participate in activities to grow their faith and dependence on each other in the group.
- I acted as Assistant Spiritual Director at VDC at Silver Birch Ranch in March in a prayer and support role.
- I attended the Ligonier Conference in Orlando Florida exploring what other groups are doing to stay true in teaching and implementing their ministries in a way that stays true to our Lord Jesus.
- I prayerfully **adhere to the values of the Bible** and strive to be an **example** for God's precious children of a clear, observable commitment to Jesus Christ.
