"Dan and Jennifer Mead trusted the educators at their daughter's public school. That is, until they saw a partially altered school record in which their daughter was referred to by a masculine name and male pronouns. The school district went out of its way to hide the fact that it was secretly treating the Meads' daughter as a boy.
